Moslems Buried In Bangladesh

Dacca (UPI)—Hundreds of wailing and weeping Bihari Moslems gathered at a block of concrete houses and huts Tuesday to bury their dead as heavily armed Bangladesh army troops searched homes for weapons.

At Sector 12 of the sprawling non-Bengali enclave in the suburban town of Mirpur, Biharis buried 21 men and one woman in a mass grave. Another 23 non-Bengalis were buried in three other sectors of Mirpur.

The dead were the victims of three days of violence between Bengali guerrillas and regular troops and the non-Bengalis accused of aiding and supporting West Pakistan during nine months of civil war last year.
